Chromebook User Consequences

UNAUTHORIZED USE OF DEVICES

Ascension Parish School Board's technology staff monitors ALL internet traffic. Parents/Guardians will be notified if their child has been flagged because of inappropriate of the device or network. Students who use a device in an inappropriate way may be subject to school disciplinary actions. These actions will be based on the severity of the inappropriate action or materials.

DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

Non-compliance with the Acceptable Use Policy or Ascension Parish School Policies may result in one or more of the followings actions: 1. Restricted use or loss of 1-to-1 device privileges. Possession of an Ascension Parish 1-to-1 device may be revoked at any time. 2. Student and parent may be required to make full financial restitution for any unauthorized expenses incurred or damaged caused by inappropriate actions. 3. Student may face school disciplinary actions based on district and school policy violations. 4. Student may face legal actions based on the severity of the actions taken.

Consequences

OFFENSES considered to be minor:

- Playing on Chromebook during class time
- Making comments on posts/documents when not authorized
- Chromebook brought to school less than 85% charged (5th grade ONLY)
- Left Chromebook in another class (5th grade ONLY)
- Transported Chromebook improperly (5th grade ONLY)
- Left Chromebook at home (5th grade ONLY first offense)

CONSEQUENCES for OFFENSES considered to be minor:

1st Offense: Warning

2nd Offense: Conduct mark/parent contact

3rd offense: Conduct mark/parent contact (3rd-5th)/Chromebook stays at school for one week (5th grade ONLY)

4th offense: Conduct mark/parent contact/Minor Infraction (3rd-5th) /Chromebook stays at school for remainder of

month (5th grade ONLY)

OFFENSES considered to be major:

- Left Chromebook at home (5th grade ONLY 2nd offense)
- Downloading and installing unauthorized apps or files such as music, games, and/or pictures on Chromebook
- Changed settings on Chromebook
- Logging in as someone else on your Chromebook
- Purposely damaging Chromebook
- Removing stickers off of Chromebook
- Cyberbullying
- Inappropriate language (translate)

CONSEQUENCES for OFFENSES considered to be major:

 1^{st} Offense: Parent notified / lose privilege of using Chromebook in class for a day (3rd-5th) /

Chromebook stays at school for a week (5th ONLY)

2nd Offense: Minor infraction / Parent notified / lose privilege of using Chromebook in class for the week (3rd-5th)

Chromebook stays at school for remainder of month (5th ONLY)

3rd Offense: Parent notified / lose privilege of using Chromebook in class for remainder of month (3rd-5th and major

referral / Chromebook stays at school for remainder of 9 weeks (5th ONLY)

Severe:

- Cleared history (ONLY teachers can clear)
- Restrictions Violations (trying to remove restrictions, change them, etc.)
- History shows inappropriate use of Chromebook
- Flagged by APSB Technology Department
